The goal of the NSS and NSPPR services is to provide information on prior art relevant for the given invention/technical solution that can help assess novelty and inventive step of an invention or technical solution. The service results in a report that includes a brief summary of the cited documents (NSS) and, in case of NSPPR, a detailed explanatory opinion on whether the invention meets the requirements of patentability in terms of novelty, inventive step and industrial applicability.

VSS offers in-depth searches of a patent specified by the customer that is in force (or has family members in force) in at least one country, with claims available in English. VSS identifies patent documents and other publications that can affect the validity of the patent in question. In addition, a detailed explanatory opinion is provided on whether the invention contained in the given patent meets the requirements of patentability in view of the cited prior art documents.

All services are performed in databases of patent and non patent literature covering the PCT Minimum Documentation and fully in line with the practice of European PCT Authorities. VSS offers in-depth searches of a patent specified by the customer that is in force (or has family members in force) in at least one country, with claims available in English.
